—NOTES on adding EDIBLES to your LANDSCAPE—

Landscapes can provide so much more for us beyond just looking great. The yard can be a place for tasty food production, useful crops, cooling shade, and truly beneficial sustainable gardening practice.

The Pedestrian Orchard or Compact Orchard

Ladders are not required if your trees are only around 7 feet tall. This eases the pruning, fruit picking, frost protection and pest reduction activities.

- **Summer Pruning for Size Control**

You are in charge of your tree size and summer pruning is the ideal time to really get the size under control. Also, because some disease spreads from pruning in wet and rainy conditions, our dry summers make it less of a problem, if done then.

- **The Lorette System of Pruning**

This old French system of shaping fruit trees has a lot to offer anyone wanting to learn all they can about the special shapes ideal to each type of fruit.

- **Espalier**

Even very narrow areas can support food production if your trees are trained on a flat plane. It's also very visually appealing against a fence or wall.

- **Hedgerows**

Growing your food crops in hedgerows has many advantages such as reduced space, multi varieties for pollination, longer and more varied selections, habitat for beneficial insects, beauty and screening your view.

- **Fruit Trees Grown in Containers**

Containers almost always dwarf your trees compared to being in the ground. This also makes moving them easier. So it's an ideal choice for renters, or anyone who might be moving.

- **Raised Beds**

Raising the level of the soil before planting will help feed the trees with added minerals in added topsoil and solve poor drainage and over-watering issues, which brings more air to the root system and reduces the chance of crown rot.

- **Multiple-Trunks Planting**

Fruit trees can be planted, with similar root stock choice, in what is sometimes called *four in a hole* or *three in a hole*. The trunks are actually 18 – 24 inches apart. Trees kept small will give you more varied food for a longer period, such as several months of different varieties rather than a few weeks of one type of fruit ripening in the same space.

- **Specialized Gardening**

Gardening is a terrific lifestyle choice for folks with differing abilities. Planning for appropriate paths and heights of beds or trees can ease gardening for use with canes, walkers or wheelchairs. Gardening is therapeutic and useful for *all* in so many ways it could fill a book.

- **Visit other Gardens**

There are so many examples of alternative-style orchards online and in books. Search *You Tube* for so many generous gardeners' ideas and pictures. Visit *Emma Prusch Park* in San Jose for examples of fruit trees in normal and pedestrian orchards, or *Fair Oaks Horticulture Park* near Sacramento for so many great examples of established intense orchards, great local varieties and non-toxic Integrated Pest Management techniques.
